A recent <u>report</u> from the ACLU of Utah offers a critical appraisal of Operation Rio Grande, the multiagency effort to address public safety and homelessness in the Pioneer Park neighborhood that began in 2017. In particular, the report criticizes the number of arrests for low-level offenses that came out of that effort, saying that "repeated interactions with the criminal justice system" created "lingering collateral consequences" for people experiencing homelessness – a population the architects of the effort were ostensibly trying to help.
