

4) You can also start tracking a bill by clicking “Track” on the results page for a Bill Search.

- 5) To track bills, however, you need to create an account at the Utah Legislature webpage
- 6) To Create a new account, click on “Login” and then, “Create New Account.”
- 7) Follow the prompts to create a specific login and password to manage your Bill Tracking on the legislative website.
- 8) If you already have a Bill Tracking account, enter your email address and password to log in.

- 10) Click on the blue link to log in to your Bill Tracking account with your new password.
- 11) When prompted, enter your password. You now have a **Bill Tracking** account linked to your email and password.



- 12) To access the Bill Tracker from the Legislative homepage, click on “Bills” in the top menu.
- 13) Then click on “Tracking Service” in the first list of menu options.
- 14) You can also access the “Tracking Service” from the landing pages for individual bills.
